

Grand County Airports Snow Removal Policy

Snow removal operations will be completed at the Granby Grand County Airport and at the McElroy Field Kremmling Airport within twenty-four (24) hours following the end of any snow event.

The airports may be closed during snow events while crews are focusing on priority roadways. Once the snow event ends, Grand County will commence snow removal operations and complete said snow removal operations within 24 hours. Appropriate NOTAM's will be issued by Grand County to indicate that the airports are closed and/or that snow removal equipment is on the runway. Once snow removal operations are finished, all appropriate NOTAM's will be cancelled by Grand County.

Pilots should call Flight Services at (800) 992-7433, option 1, to obtain the status of the airports. By calling Flight Services, pilots will be able to hear current NOTAM information.

Hangar owners and lessees are responsible for fifteen (15) feet in front of their hangar, however, during snow removal operations, Grand County will remove snow in front of hangars as close as reasonably possible based on snow amount, ice buildup, etc. to allow hangar owners as much assistance as possible without damage to the hangars. Hangar owners/lessees are responsible for removing the remaining snow in a manner which does not interfere with Grand County's snow removal operations or the snow removal efforts of other hangar owners/lessees.
