



**HOT SULPHUR SPRINGS-PARSHALL VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT**

A tract of land lying West of the Parshall-to-Williams Fork County Road and the most Southern part of the Grand County Shop Tract, all in the South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the North West  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 1 North, Range 78 West of the 6th. Principal Meridian, Grand County, Colorado containing 0.38 acres more or less and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at the North East Corner of the Tract, a point on the Westerly Right-of-way Line of the Parshall to Williams Fork County Road, also a point on the Easterly Property line of the Grand County Shops Tract WHENCE the North  $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner of Section 18, T1N, R.78 W. 6th. P.M. bears N.36°49'E. for 1,865.85 feet THENCE along said Grand County Tract S.03°37' W. for 52.82 feet, thence on a curve to the right with a radius of 1,273.3 feet for a distance of 127.18 feet, thence N. 40°38' W. for 274.7 feet, thence S.81°02'E. for 183.00 feet to the point of beginning.
