



## Grand County Road & Bridge Driveway Permit Instructions & Requirements

- Center line of proposed driveway, as well as property corners, must be staked/flagged before submitting application.
- Property address must be posted on the lot prior to submitting application.
- A detailed sketch of the worksite showing the placement of the driveway including adjacent property lines and any adjacent driveways or roadways must accompany this application.
- A site inspection will be conducted by Grand County Road & Bridge (GCRB) within five (5) business days of receiving a completed application, weather providing.
- Driveway inspections will occur between April 15 and Oct 15 or as the weather allows. Depending on snow cover additional requirements may be imposed at the Foreman's discretion.
- Upon completion of driveway construction, the Applicant/Excavator/Contractor must contact GCRB for a final inspection of the driveway.
- If the driveway fails to pass final inspection, deficiencies must be addressed/repared within ten (10) days of being notified of needed repairs. *A re-inspection fee of \$100 may be assessed.*
- Driveway design must be in compliance with the Grand County Road & Bridge Standards, found at: <https://www.co.grand.co.us/DocumentCenter/View/9240/Current-Road-and-Bridge-Standards>
- Applicant/Excavator/Contractor will take any and all measures to ensure the safety of all travelers over, around and through the construction site.
- Excavated materials will not be stored at the work site or in the County Right-of-Way that may obstruct traffic in any manner.
- Applicant/Excavator/Contractor is required to contact Colorado Utility Locator for location of utilities at site of construction. Dial 811 from any phone or go to [colorado811.org](http://colorado811.org) to enter a ticket.
