



US 34 North of Granby Resurfacing Project *speed limits to be strictly enforced*

Traffic Update: June 22 to June 26

Ongoing Traffic Impacts

The US 34 north of Granby resurfacing project will begin on US Highway 34 at Mile Point 0 and will continue for 15 miles to MP 15, north of Granby. Work will also take place on US Highway 40 from MP 210.95 to MP 211.25, near the intersection of US 40 and US 34. Motorists can expect east and westbound shoulder closure on US 40 and a north and southbound shoulder closure on US 34.

Work this week will consist of sign placement.

Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Friday from 7 a.m. to 12 p.m.
