<p>Temporary Food Full Service Permit <i>Tent/table vendor cooking/ preparing</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fee, see GCEH fee schedule • Can attend Coordinated Events • Must complete Temp Food Vendor Application • Handwashing required on site 	<p>Temporary Food Limited Permit <i>Tent/table vendor with pre-packaged TCS foods and limited unpackaged foods such as roasted nuts, ice cream, iced non-TCS drinks, and packaging of bread.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fee, see GCEH fee schedule • Can attend Coordinated Events • Must complete Temp Food Vendor Application • Handwashing required on site 	<p>Non-Profit Temporary Food Establishment <i>Non-profit Tent/table vendor with both TCS and non-TCS foods</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No fee • Can attend Coordinated Events in Grand County • Handwashing required on site 	<p>Mobile Unit License <i>A food truck, pushcart or pre-packaged mobile licensed in any county in Colorado except for City and County of Denver</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No additional fee • Can attend any event • No application required if already licensed, provide copy of license • Hot and cold running water on unit required <p><i>*If Mobile Unit is operating with an extension of the unit (tent/table setup) they will require a Temp Food Permit as well</i></p>
<p>City and County of Denver/ Out of State Mobile Unit License <i>A food truck or pushcart licensed only in the City and County of Denver or Out of State</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot operate in Grand County without additional licensing • May apply for a Temp Food Permit to operate at Coordinated Events only • Handwashing required on site 	<p>Cottage Foods Vendor <i>Vendor operating under Colorado Cottage Foods Act.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No fee • Can attend any event • No application required • Must comply with all Cottage Foods requirements • Sampling is permitted <p>https://cdphe.colorado.gov/cottage-foods-act</p>	<p>Sampler <i>Vendor sampling a food product</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No fee • Can attend any event • No application required • Foods must be handled hygienically and be a true sample size • Handwashing may be required on site 	<p>Packaged, non-TCS food sales from Licensed Facility <i>A licensed restaurant or Wholesaler with packaged non-TCS foods only</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No fee • Can attend any event • No application required • Foods must be from an approved source, packaged, and non-TCS

*TCS foods are foods that require time or temperature control for food safety

*All food vendors are responsible for abiding by the Colorado Retail Food Establishment Rules and Regulations
