Our Services

The **P.A.I.N.S.** Program ...

- Assists uninsured adults ages 18-64 in need of financial resources for medical services.
- ... Provides medical vouchers for acute, non-emergent medical care.
- ... Allows qualifying adults to choose their provider, here in Grand County.
- ... Provides up to 3 vouchers per year for each household.
- ... Requires a \$10 administration fee per voucher.
- ... Is NOT an insurance program.
- ... Is NOT an answer to the Health Care Crisis in Grand County.
- ... Does NOT provide hospital visits, ER visits, refill medications, pregnancy or birth control, or chronic illness care.
- ... Does NOT cover subsequent visits to specialists, out-of-county doctors, surgical consultations, further diagnostics, etc.

Adults between the ages of 18-64 who are *without public or private insurance* and meet the financial qualifications.
